PUB UPDATE

Most of you hopefully will have seen much activity at The Royal George over the last two months.

The difficulties which were encountered with the road closure have been overcome and by the time you read this we will be a few weeks into the road closure. This will enable the various trades to complete the refurbishment to the front of the pub and complete the new roof.

At the same time work continues behind the main building and progress is being made.

This is the first stage of the refurbishment and all being well The Royal George will look much better towards the end of 2024.

As Mr Hern has stated previously, the whole Royal George development is driven by the sales at Webbs Meadow. Currently, whilst the planning applications for this site remain held up, further progress beyond the year end may be held up until the planning is resolved.

VILLAGE TRAFFIC

The closure of the A480 at The George has caused some traffic chaos in the village with some HGVs using the local lanes. It is hoped that extra signage can be in place so HGVs will start to follow the diversion route. The 461 bus service will use the C 1031, except the double decker school services.
