PUB UPDATE

Some of you will have already noticed there is activity at the Royal George.

Mr Hern provided an update at the recent Parish Council meeting and explained a timber frame is already ordered and is expected to be erected over the basement area in the first week of September. He also confirmed he is in difficult negotiations with Balfour Beatty, seeking a road closure at the front of the property to permit necessary works on the roof and pub frontage. It is hoped that an agreement can be reached very soon to ensure the safety of his workers and all traffic travelling through the village. The road closure is expected, but not yet confirmed, from 18th September to 30th November, so there will be some local disruption.

Finally, he reiterated that the pub development would be driven by the developments at Webbs Meadow and whilst the planning applications make no progress works on the pub may be held up.

WHITE LION MEADOW



There was good attendance for the Wildlife Meadow Official Opening on a lovely day at the end of June coinciding with the Lyonshall Open Garden event.

The most pleasing sight was the number of parents with young families that attended and spent time talking to the happy helper volunteers and members of Kington Branch Herefordshire Wildlife Trust.

The young children were fascinated with the pond area, identifying pond species together with butterflies and moths within the meadow area. The hope is that we can keep the entrance gate unlocked to facilitate access and interest.



Recently, a lady who was an evacuee to Lyonshall in WWII visited the meadow. She had fond memories of staying with an aunt and playing in the field with local children. She has kindly donated a Malus Golden Glory crab apple tree which was planted at the opening.



Sadly, evidence of bad behaviour by irresponsible dog owners has been found on the mown paths.
