## WHITE LION MEADOW NEWS



The team has planted around 20 native trees in the meadow including field maple, silver birch, hazel, crab apple, wild cherry, wild pear, wild plum, bird cherry and rowan. The trees are about 1 metre tall because they establish and flourish better when planted small. The meadow has been

given for the community to enjoy but please respect the wildlife that is establishing. The area is not appropriate for dogs so please remember **NO DOGS.** Children are very welcome but please ensure they are aware of the nature of the area.
